BURKE PHYSICAL EDUCATION GRADING GUIDELINES

Grades are computed every nine weeks (quarterly).

ACTIVITY GRADE

Each activity will be graded in the follow manner:

30% - written test over rules, playing area, vocabulary and history.

20% - skill test - basic skills needed to participate in activity.

50% - participation and cooperation. Deductions in this area include:

- 1. Too many absences, no make-ups. (All absences should be made up.)
- 2. Not following directions or not doing assigned tasks.
- 3. All uncooperative behavior and inappropriate language which includes:
 - a) Language to staff or students of a disrespectful or insulting nature.
 - b) Statements to teachers of a defiant and argumentative nature.
 - c) Refusal to abide by organizational directives or rules of the activity.
- 4. Disruption of the educational environment including fighting (real or staged), behavior that is of an annoying nature to students or teachers, and noise created when silence is the directive.
- 5. Not handing in assigned work.
- 6. Not suiting up for an activity.

PLEASE NOTE: Not suiting up four (4) times in an activity may result in a grade of "5" for that activity.

DAILY PARTICIPATION GRADE

Every student starts off each day with 10 daily points. When a student behaves appropriately, dresses properly and is on time to class each day, she/he will keep all those points. Proper and acceptable attire for Physical Education class is described on Page 2 of the Burke Physical Education Rules and Regulations (t-shirt, shorts, sweat clothes, and footwear). Any additional clothing worn to Physical Education is subject to the approval of the Burke Physical Education Department and could be cause for the subtraction of daily participation points. Sweatshirts and sweat bottoms may be worn only in addition to gym clothes for outdoor activities. Duties which are assigned for completion in the Computer Lab are also considered part of the daily participation points. Failure to cooperate and follow instructions in the computer lab will result in participation point deductions. The following illustrates a sample of deduction points for various violations:

Not suiting up	10
Tardy to class	
Disruptive behavior	
Disruptive behavior which requires an office referral	
Student is not properly attired as described in the Burke P.E. Rules and Regulations	
Student wearing jewelry	5
(earrings that hang below ear lobe, rings, watches, bracelets, necklaces)	
Student chewing gum, candy or food in gym	5
Student not exercising during warm-up period	
Student not participating in the cardiovascular portion of class
