

September 22 is State ACT Make Up Test Day for Seniors

No remote learning for students in grades 9, 10, and 11

September 23 will be an odd remote learning day 9-12

On Tuesday, September 22, Omaha Public Schools are offering the opportunity for seniors to take the State ACT Make Up Test, in person, during the school day. Students scheduled to take the ACT in April 2020 were not able to test due to the pandemic. An RSVP survey was emailed to seniors the week of August 31, to see if they were planning on attending school on September 22. If plans have changed, seniors may still attend to take the State ACT Make Up Test. Eligible students who indicated a need for transportation will receive an email with details. Breakfast and lunch will be offered. Students will be dismissed early afternoon after testing is completed.

Attendance is encouraged, and it is important that seniors arrive at school on time (7:40 a.m.). The test takes approximately 4 hours and requires an environment with no distractions. Students with approved accommodations may take longer, you were sent a personal letter if this applies to your student.

As we continue to place the health and safety of all students and staff at the forefront, please know that our school will maintain COVID-19 safety measures on test day to ensure your student's safety to the greatest extent possible. Facial coverings will be required while in the building, hand sanitizer is available in every testing room, and we will be spacing students out to the best of our ability. Please do not send your student to test on September 22 if they have a fever, are not feeling well or have been potentially exposed to anyone who may be or is known to be positive for COVID-19

Upon arrival students should go to their assigned testing room. There will be signs to help students find their way, these are alphabetical by last name so this guide should help some.

<u>Last name</u>	<u>Room range</u>
A – Mad	200-225 second floor, west side of the main stairs
Man – Tac	101-129 first floor, west of the main stairs
Tat – White	IC1, IC2, 132 all these classrooms are in the library
White – Z	140-142 first floor, east of the main stairs

- Students with accommodations will have different room assignments. Students specifically with Time and one half are all in room 132-144. Students should check with a staff member to confirm their test locations.

Once in testing rooms students will be directed to their seats, they will be asked to turn off electronic devices and place those in bags for secure storage during the test. Food and drink are not permitted in testing rooms, we will have pencils and calculators for all seniors to use during the test.
